CIVIL AIR PATROL MEMBERSHIP

CAPM 39-2, 4 December 2003 is supplemented as follows:

1-1d (added). **Political Activity:** Texas Wing members are encouraged to establish and maintain harmonious relationships with State and Federal officials. Members are also encouraged to participate as private citizens in all aspects of the political process. However under no circumstances should any CAP members expend funds, CAP or personal, or attempt to advocate any specific political position while representing or appearing to represent the Civil Air Patrol. Only the Wing Commander, Director of Government Affairs or designated representative may officially represent the Texas Wing of the Civil Air Patrol.

2-4b(3). Units will NOT forward the CAP Form 15 for each new cadet member to the wing headquarters.

2-4b(5) (added) The unit personnel officer will establish a suspense file to ensure that the new member's name appears on the Cadet Monthly

Membership Listing (MML) form National Headquarters and that the member receives a membership card within 60 days. If new cadets are issued applications for uniform items from National Headquarters, commanders will insure that the uniform items are ordered and items are returned to the unit when the cadet leaves the program.

3-5b(3). Units will NOT forward to the wing headquarters a copy of the CAP Form 12 for each new senior member.

3-5b(5) (added) The unit personnel officer should establish a suspense file to ensure that a new member's name appears on the Senior Monthly Membership Listing (MML) from national Headquarters and the members receives a membership card within 60 days.
