Training

CAP SENIOR MEMBER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

CAPR 50-17, 1 March 2003 is supplemented as follows:

2-3 Testing. All units that have cadets registered must have a Cadet programs Test Control Officer (TCO). Cadet programs TCO and alternates are designated IAW CAPR 52-16 on CAPF 53. Senior programs Test Control Officers (TCO) are designated on a letter, or preferably on a Personnel Authorization (PA). Professional development (AFIADL) TCOs are designated IAW CAPR50-4 on a letter, or preferably on a PA, from the Unit Commander. TCO alternates are designated on a letter, or preferably on a PA, from the TCO. The same individuals may serve as TCO for Cadet Programs, Senior and AFIADL. A copy of each CAPF53/Letter/PA will be forwarded to Wing HQ whenever a change in these personnel or the appointing commander occurs.

2-5 e Criteria for Awards. There is no application for Membership and Leadership Awards. The unit commander approves these via a CAPF2a filed in the member's CAPF45 folder (see sec 3-7). Subsequent awards of stars for the Leadership Award are approved and documented in a like manner (see sec 5-2 and 6-2).

2-9 Appointment of Course Directors for SLS/CLC/ UCC. (Added) Course Directors will be appointed by the Wing Commander in the form of a PA. Recommendations will be forwarded to the Wing DPD through the Group Commander. Once the director has been appointed they will coordinate with the Plans and Programs Officer to schedule the date on the Wing Calendar and then submit the CAPF46 and an Operation Plan (OpPlan) for the desired course to the Wing DPD and eMail/Fax the CAPF 46 to National Headquarters not less than 60 days prior to the course.

3-8 Reporting. The Wing DPD copy of the CAPF11 for Orientation and CPPT training will be forwarded to Wing HQ by any means by which a hard file copy may be made.

4-6 Squadron Leadership School

Sec b - How Conducted. Each group is expected to offer an SLS once a year. However, if there are insufficient officers in the group needing this training, the group commander may opt to cooperate with a neighboring group to provide this training.

5-3 Corporate Learning Course

Sec c - How Conducted. Each group is expected to offer a CLC once a year. However, if there are insufficient officers in the group needing this training, the group commander may opt to cooperate with a neighboring group to provide this training.

7-1 Executive

Sec c (1) Unit Commanders Course. The Wing DPD is expected to offer a UCC at least once a year, more often as needed. Group Commanders desiring to sponsor a course should contact the Wing DPD to coordinate a UCC. (See Section 2.9)

8-1 AFIADL

B 3 (d) Course Examinations. Upon receipt of a Course Examination for a member, the Wing TCO will retain a copy of the front of the envelope, with the examinee's name showing, and then forward the test to the members units TCOs address. In the event that either testing officer is a test participant, the other testing officer shall receive /administer /oversee that test. In the event that both TCOs are unavailable or are both test participants, the next higher command level TCO shall act as testing officer. In no event will the unit commander act as a TCO
