MEMORANDUM FOR CAP REGION AND WING COMMANDERS

SUBJECT: Change to Civil Air Patrol (CAP) Calendar Month Oil Change Requirements

1. CAP aircraft calendar month oil change requirements listed in CAP Regulation (CAPR) 66-1, paragraph 9a3) have been changed from 4 to 6 months. New text will read "Oil changes shall not exceed 6 calendar months for both systems listed under paragraphs 9a1) and 9a2)." The oil change must be accomplished on or prior to the last day of the sixth calendar month.
2. This change does not amend the requirement for the mid-cycle oil change which must be performed between 40 and 60 hours after the last 100-hour or annual inspection.
3. Wing maintenance officers will ensure that aircraft oil and filter changes are accomplished and engine logbooks are annotated in accordance with the schedule published in CAPR 66-1 and this policy letter.
