

Civil Air Patrol ACE Curriculum Science Alignment for Texas

This document was created to assist Texas educators in aligning the curriculum provided by the Civil Air Patrol to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). The Science TEKS are located on TEA's website <http://ritter.tea.state.tx.us/rules/tac/chapter112/index.html>. This chart is color coded by the Civil Air Patrol's ACE curriculum binders and activities are in the columns that correspond to the grade level they should be taught according to the state's standards. The number and letter following the name of the activity are the TEKS that align to the activity. For example, the kindergarten binder contains the activity Look up in the Sky, but this activity aligns to the 1st grade standard 1.5A and therefore should be taught in 1st grade not kindergarten.
